<b>Equipo:</b> Cuerdas: 2x 50m		
<b>Resumen:</b> (traducción alternativa) North-facing tour that is very cold, even though there is no glacier in the catchment area. A few very nice parts, but interrupted by long block passages.		
<b>Hidrología:</b> (traducción alternativa) The water level hardly moves there, meaning that the canyon is rarely flushed (renamed Glissebach in French, "sliding stream"), and at the same time will never reach a depth of water.		
<b>Acceso:</b> (traducción alternativa) Depending on where you get in, park closer to Bramisegg or Axalp.		
<b>Acceso:</b> (traducción alternativa) There are many ways to get in. The most exciting is the Botchechlempen. Before that, there are often only a few steps and a lot of scree.		
<b>Recorrido:</b> (traducción alternativa) It's very cold in the Botchechlempen, so you're almost glad you have to walk from time to time afterwards to warm up again. If the stream is not slippery, a few higher, very technical jumps are certainly possible, but usually only the small and medium ones will be feasible.  The second part, "Botchechinni", is very narrow, with two very dangerous consecutive glacier potholes, so be careful not to slide into them.
