Matériel:		
Résumé: (traduction alternative) Unknown ravine in the Varón river under the mallata and Piniecho peak that give it its name. Its lack of knowledge is due to its very long approach of almost three hours through losing terrain. With facilities to be reviewed but very nice aesthetically speaking and with a lot of character. In rainy season it will be better not to make it because it has a great basin that can give us problems. The return is usually made by the Laulot ravine.		
Hydrologie: (traduction alternative) In the first part, in the narrow area it is difficult and compromised.		
Accès: (traduction alternative) By the N260 from Sabiñánigo to Biescas. We will continue straight on towards France on the A136 until the detour to Panticosa, which we will take and continue towards Baños de Panticosa. 1 km after leaving Panticosa we have on the right a track that goes down to a picnic area (access to the Ripera Valley). We will park the car before the chain that closes the pass.		
Approche: (traduction alternative) We will follow the track on foot for about 6kms until the bridge over the Laulot ravine, at this point there is a path to the left that goes up a steep climb to overcome a strip, after a while the road turns 90 degrees to the right to go in search of a small hill that leads to a first ravine, we will overcome it and a hill after we will see our ravine with a larger basin under the peaks Piniecho, Serrato and Batanes. It is a long, hard and a little losing ascent once we leave the track.		
Tour: (traduction alternative) A first part to evaluate the flow before entering the narrows. If in the first part we have problems it is better to abandon because it is a funnel. Here begins the most sporty part.		
Retour: (traduction alternative) We will arrive at the Laulot ravine, we can descend it to the bridge of the track or cross it towards the Mallata de Yenefrito to go down a path to the track.

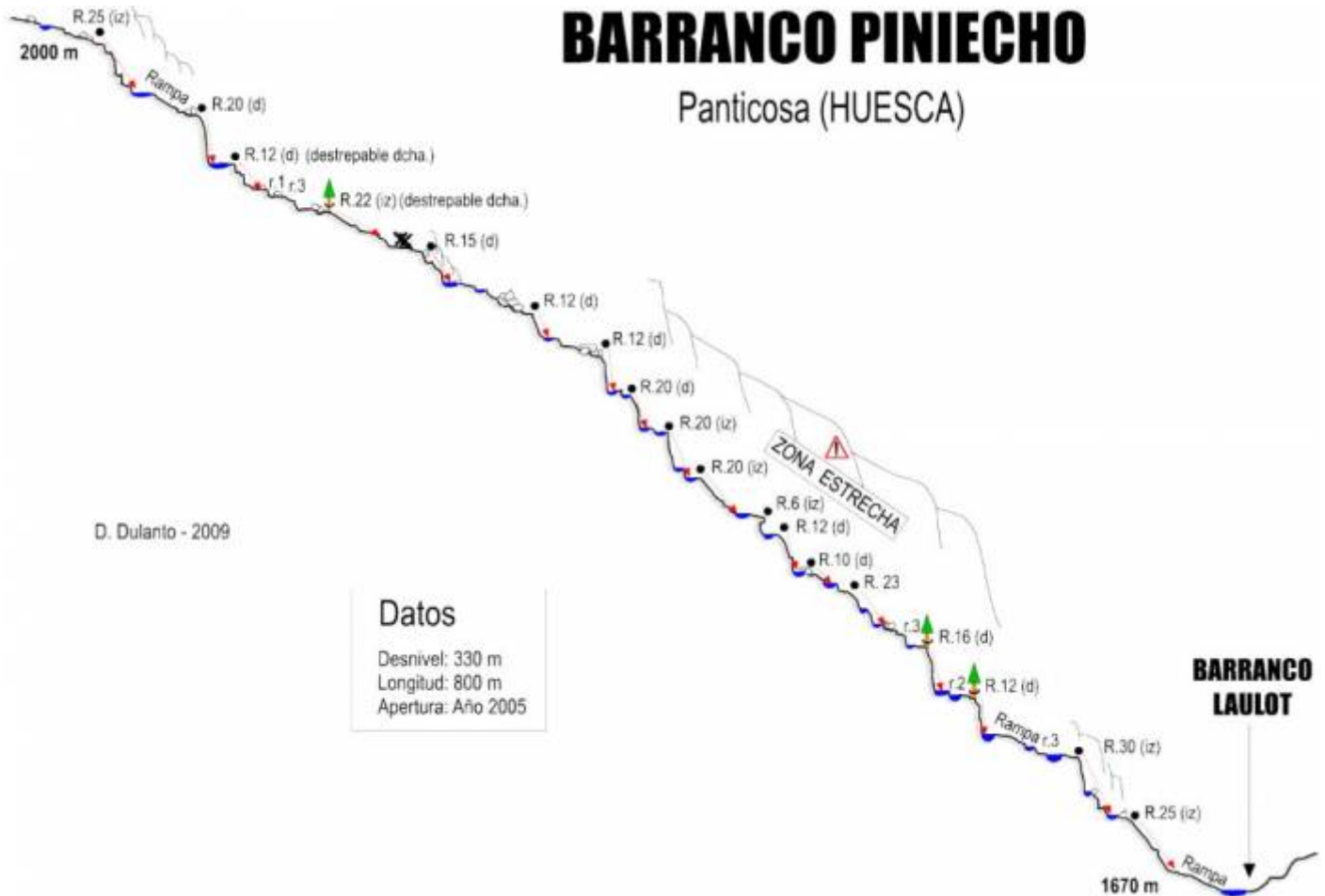
