Résumé: (traduction alternative) Short aquatic canyon with a few rappels and some possible jumps. A short but fascinating tour due to the transparency of the water and the long pools in the depths of the canyon. Don't miss the long and narrow water slide at the exit of the canyon and the pool into which you can jump from various heights. Practically a fun water park.		
Hydrologie:		
Accès: (traduction alternative) see Google approach from Rovereto in photo gallery: there is a large parking lot by the river. From Roverto, take the S.S 46 towards Vallarsa as far as the Eremo di San Colombano, where you can park near the entrance to the hydroelectric power station.		
Approche: (traduction alternative) From the parking lot down into the wide and open streambed. Then a few meters downstream to the first rappel. Access: go back on foot and take the closed road towards San Nicolo. Cross a tunnel and climb over a mudslide that blocks the road to a large square below the road. The canyon begins at the dam wall.		
Tour: (traduction alternative) 4 rappels, possible jumps, swimming routes		
Retour: (traduction alternative) After the road bridge, turn left and cross the bridge to the orographic right bank. From here along the road to the parking lot (it makes sense for one person to fetch the car and the others to wait).
