Résumé: (traduction alternative) Relatively open downclimb and rappel canyon with scenic access		
Hydrologie:		
Accès: (traduction alternative) Whether coming on the A26 from Alexandria or on the A10 from Genoa or Savona, leave the A10 at the Voltri exit and head west on the SS1 Aurelia (Via Pra) parallel to the coast for 2.2 km. Just before the bridge over the Cerusa river, turn right and go north for 3.6 km (from the junction) to Fabbriche. From Fabbriche we continue on this road for 700 m and then, after passing under the A26, we turn left towards Sambuco. We now descend 240 m to the bridge over the river. Immediately after the bridge the road to the right and in serpentine upwards into the valley of the Rio Secco. We keep to the orographic left side of the slope and cross the Rio Secco 1.7 km after this bridge. 90 m further we park the car in a prominent left serpentine (here you can immediately see the 'ProCanyon' info board).		
Approche: (traduction alternative) The best information is provided by the map from the ProCanyon description with the access marked in brown: http://www.canyoning.it/procanyon/secco/cartasecco.jpg . You should always look for the markers (blue dot on white rectangle) on this scenic access, especially where the trail gets lost a few times between the bushes in the upper third. In addition, the following. Info: From the parking lot, follow the exit trail upstream for about 30m, then cross the stream below the large but shallow pool and follow clear tracks up to a dirt road. Take this to the left, just past the house to the left across the meadow and up to a footpath. This brings us to the houses of the hamlet of Soggi (455 m above sea level). We hike through the hamlet and then take a grassy dirt road that runs almost horizontally in a wide arc across the meadows (first towards NNW) towards the Niederwald. From here we follow the path that leads out to the meadows at an altitude of about 600 m and in a wide arc, passing a ruin, to the stream.		
Tour: (traduction alternative) Much rappel in the canyon, partly also in places where attractive rappel would offer. A necessary anchor (at the water drainage) is missing anno 2013 (alternatively from the tree). In general rappel outside the beam possible. In summer too little water flow ('Secco' = dry).		
Retour: (traduction alternative) Either you climb right after the orange iron footbridge up to a slope and then down to the car - or you go about 200 m further until a clear path is visible on the right bank. Then follow this path downstream to the car.
