Hydrologie: (traduction alternative) Possible all year round, but canyoning is prohibited from February 15 to June 15. In very cold winters, ice cascades can occur!			
Accès: (traduction alternative) From Ornans, drive to Lods and then to Mouthier-Haute-Pierre. At the entrance to the village, take the first road leading down to the Loue towards the campsite. Park in the canoe parking lot.			
Approche: (traduction alternative) From the parking lot, take the GR that climbs up to Chatelet.			
Tour: (traduction alternative) A series of waterfalls that are not surrounded by rock faces. Relays in the form of ropes and chain links around the trees. You can bypass the first waterfall by 50 m by taking a vague path to the left in the first hairpin bend of the GR after crossing the road. You then walk along the road from above, past the road shelters. An escape is possible on the other side. The part below the road is closed to canyoning in order to protect the tufa concretions. The Natura 2000 biotope regulation prohibits climbing and canyoning on the Baume rock face and the Syratus waterfalls from February 15 to June 15. You are hiking on very sensitive tufa, so please be careful... A very beautiful descent that must be protected and respected! This descent can serve as an abseil point after climbing La Baume rock.			
Retour: (traduction alternative) Follow the road towards the source of the Loue to rejoin the path used during the approach.
