Little known ravine next to Santa Maria de Buil, interesting rappels, especially the last one of almost 40m, beautiful surroundings with views of the 3 Sorores. We will only find it with water in spring after heavy rains.

**Hydrologie:** (traduction alternative)

Just before the long rappel and the tributary to the left

**Accès:** (traduction alternative)

On the N260 between Boltaña and Ainsa at km. 442.8 over the bridge, turn to Arcusa and Barcabo on the A-2205. Or from Ainsa, just across the bridge the A-2205 to Guaso and Barcabo.

In both cases we will pass Guaso and continue south towards Barcabo for 7kms until the detour to the left to Santa María de Buil and Sarratillo.

Access to Santa María de Buil

Just at the entrance of Sta M<sup>a</sup> there is a track on the right where there is a sign for the trails. We parked in this area.

**Approche:** (traduction alternative)

We will leave by a small path to the east to cross with the "water course", when we reach it we will continue the course until we reach the first difficulties.

If we want to access by the tributary we will follow the track north about 350m until we turn off on the path to the right (return) to go to the watercourse of the tributary.

Scheme of Canaletas and its tributary

Rappels in natural with enough frictions, good formations and environment until the arrival to the long rappel, just at that moment we have the left tributary on the left.

**Retour:** (traduction alternative)

After the last rappel we continue along the ravine for almost 700m to go left to take the watercourse of this other tributary. We will go up to the watershed where we will find a path that heads south, we will follow it to the parking lot. We will pass by the access to the tributary

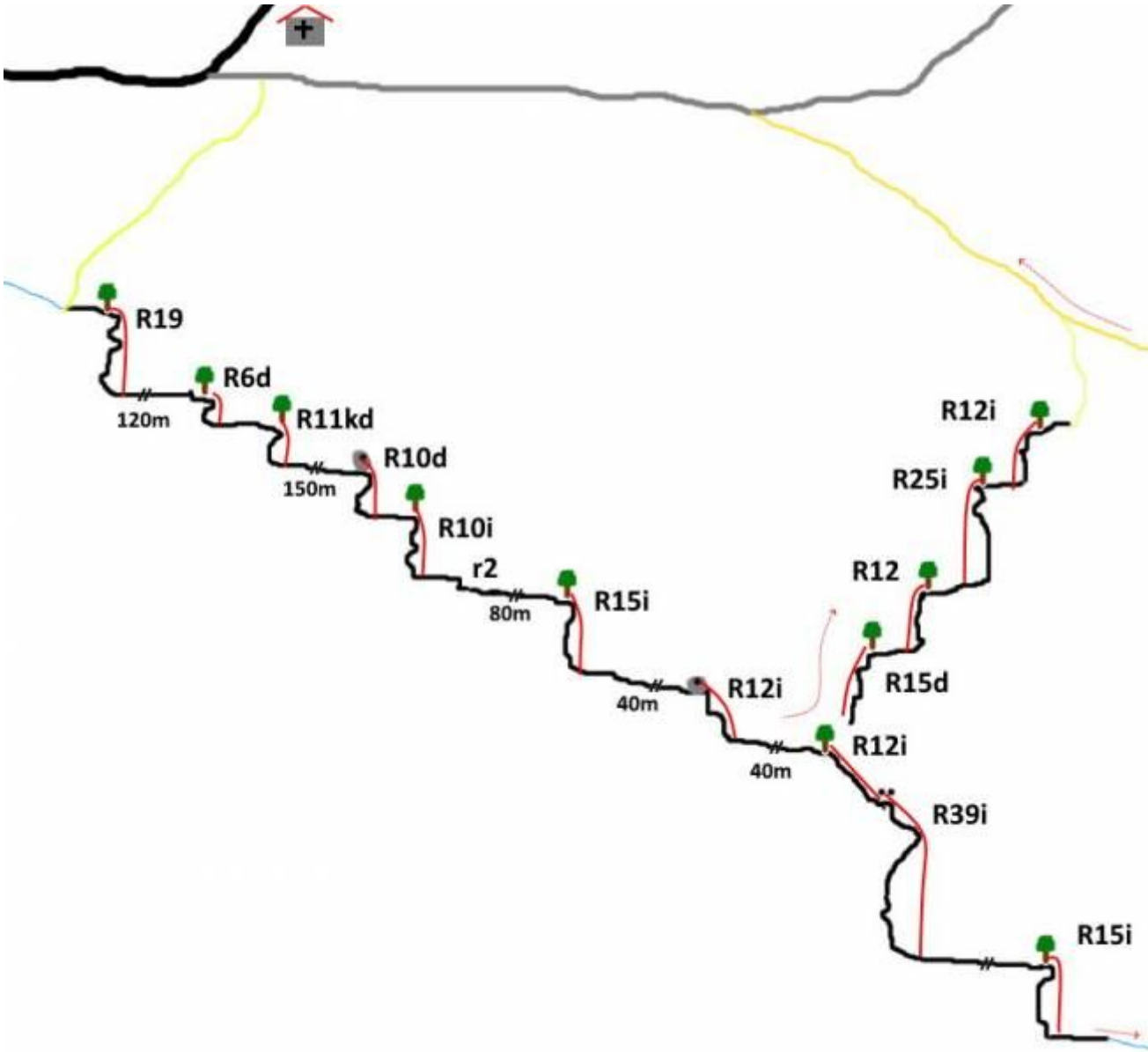
