Résumé: (traduction alternative) Around ten abseils follow each other without interruption. Narrow and rugged passages, vertical and even cave-like at the exit.		
Hydrologie: (traduction alternative) Some alternative routes, but sometimes very difficult due to the steep gradient, which makes it difficult to avoid safely. Dry canyon that only carries water after a few days of heavy rainfall.		
Accès: (traduction alternative) At the starting point of the Mas Soler slope (parking lot below the Gourg des Anelles), park on the widening at the edge of the road in the hairpin bend.		
Approche: (traduction alternative) Take the "Mas Soler" path on foot and follow the blue marked path to the exit of the "Gourg des Anelles". As soon as you reach the bank, you are on the right bank of the Vaillère. Cross the river immediately and head to the other bank, where you will find a small, overgrown path that meets a very old path a few meters further up. Walk for about eight hundred meters on this path, which is not passable, and then climb up the forest on an old path located on the left at 300 meters. It joins another blue marker much higher up below the Mas Lamouré, this time on a concreted path to the entrance gate of the Mas (hikers have access, small opening on the right). Behind the gate, continue along the path, then a path branches off to the right in a sharp left-hand bend and leads below the Mas Lamouré. The path sometimes loses its way a little, never go downhill as the paths lead in the other direction down the valley to the start of the Mas Cal Sant canyon. Always keep your position by climbing up to the left below the forest towards the southeast. You will quickly find your way back to the path. This detour avoids disturbing the residents in front of their property. Back on the path, after a few steps, a path on the left leads up to the ruins of Can Guix. Walk past the ruins and descend to the beginning of the canyon.		
Tour: (traduction alternative) Around ten abseils follow each other without interruption. Narrow and rugged passages, vertical and even cave-like at the exit.		

Retour: (traduction alternative)

The way back is the same as for the Gourg des Anelles canyon, as the exit of the Adrien canyon flows into it.

If you think there is too much water in the Anelles, follow the entire left bank to the exit.

If there is too much water in the Anelles, bypass this passage (boulder chaos) at the point where it is possible by downclimbing on the left bank or over a tree and finish the route by floating.
