Tour along the Altuzarra stream, descending its 3 large waterfalls, all within a beautiful beech forest.

Hydrologie: (traduction alternative)

You can leave the riverbed at any time

Accès: (traduction alternative)

We leave the Zarcia recreational area heading south up the Urbión River.

Approche: (traduction alternative)

We will follow the indication of the signs "waterfalls". Shortly after starting there is a fork in the trail, we continue to the left. After about 800 meters we cross a bridge and a little later a path comes out on the right, next to a house. The trail is marked with green and white signs. The trail is technical. It goes up to the "Majada de las Cabras" 1200 meters above sea level. We will continue descending to the Altuzarra River. At this point the trail is lost, we will go up the riverbed, looking for the most comfortable areas to progress. We continue overcoming the waterfalls that we will then rappel by its side arriving at the double waterfall where, in its superior part, the first installation that gives beginning to the ravine is located.

Tour: (traduction alternative)

1st Rappel: 28 meters Natural (tree). Right

2nd Rappel: 14 meters. 2 parabolts of 10. Left.

3rd Rappel: 28 meters. Natural (tree). Left

4th Rappel: 13 meters. Natural (tree). Right

Between the third and fourth rappel you have to walk 300 meters through the ravine.

Retour: (traduction alternative)

After the fourth rappel, we will skip the path by which we have accessed, leaving it to the left, to continue along the riverbed for about 200 meters to reach the Urbión river.

We will ford it looking for the path on the opposite slope. We will continue along the path down the valley and north direction until the parking, about 2 kms. 30'.

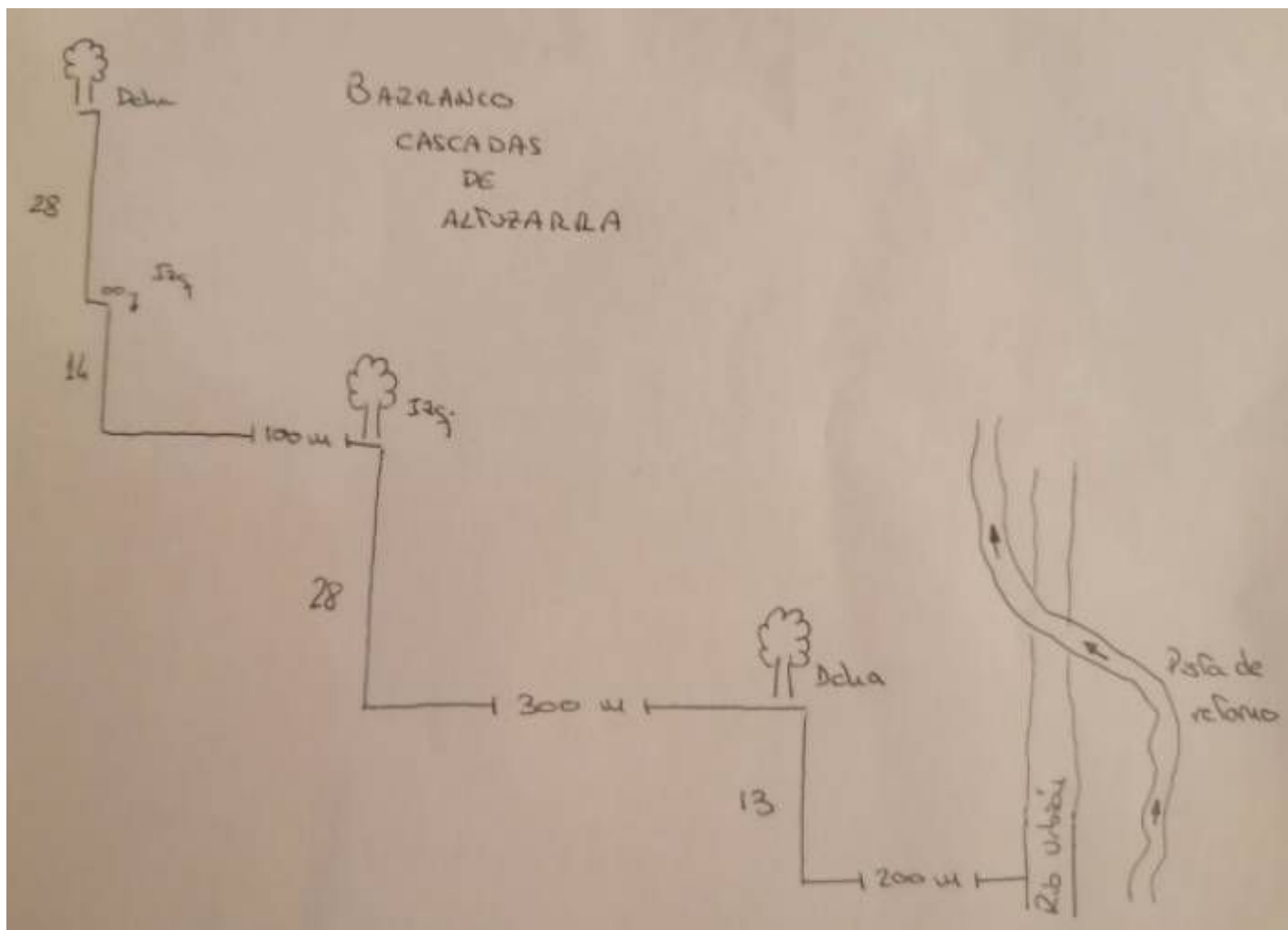
