Résumé: (traduction alternative) Short canyon, quickly accessible after rain.		
Hydrologie: (traduction alternative) The amount of water can be assessed at the bridge over the "Ri della Terra di Fuori".		
Accès: (traduction alternative) Into the Maggia Valley until a car bridge between Ronchini and Maggia leads to the orographic right-hand side of the Maggia in the village of Moghegno. On this side of the Maggia, return via the "Ri di Dentro" to Aurigeno as far back as the bridge over the "Ri della Terra di Fuori". Park at this bridge and assess the water level.		
Approche: (traduction alternative) From the parking lot, cross the bridge over the "Ri della Terra di Fuori" to the orographic right side of the stream. Take the first hiking trail on the right towards "Ronco dell'Orto" or Chiazza. Pass the second bridge on the left (from the ascent point of view) and continue uphill. At the next junction, keep right towards "Chiazza" and cross the water again. In Chiazza, turn left/uphill. Now either take the large hairpin bend over "Valecc" or the hairpin bends directly to the small chapel on the ridge. From the small chapel, without gaining any height, follow the tracks of a path through the undergrowth to the stream.		
Tour: (traduction alternative) At the beginning beautiful abseiling point(s) followed by a varied river walk with beautiful individual sections.		
Retour: (traduction alternative) From the bridge over the road back to the parking lot
