Résumé: (traduction alternative) Dry canyon with cantilevered rappels, with hanging facilities for 2 people and beautiful corners to discover. Perfect to combine with Coix or Pinella. Better if you go with pruning shears for the return and between all of us we leave the way clear.		
Hydrologie: No		
Accès: (traduction alternative) We have to go to Vistabella del Maestrazgo where we will arrive by the CV170. Access Bcos Olles, Mas Coix and Pinella Once in the village, follow the road towards Peñagolosa NP, after passing Les cases de l'Alfori take the CV1720 to the right. Continue in a straight line for a couple of kilometers to a watering place and a water pond where a track / road to the right. Just before reaching the GR it becomes a track. Follow the GR towards the Ermita de San Bartolomé (on the left). The first ravine that we will see in front is Olles, we follow the GR for almost 3kms where we will see the next watercourse, on the next hill we have a place to park.		
Approche: (traduction alternative) We will go down the hill where we can (there is no clear path) with the bco del Agua on the left until almost where the trees end, time to throw us to the riverbed because we reached the first rappel. In some guides they speak to follow the riverbed from the superior part instead of going down the hill... it can that it is more dressed and of worse progress.		
Tour: (traduction alternative) A first rappel to approach the first vertical. In the first vertical we will find a small rappel to a generally dry pool, then an approach rappel with diverter to not pendular and finally the hanging installation, for two people in a huge spectacular shelter. We will continue and we will find the next vertical, in this case an access rappel of 10m and then another hanging installation for 2 pers. The third section begins with an area of blocks and skills to reach a natural rappel that leaves us on the highest vertical, 35m, again hanging.		

Retour: (traduction alternative)

After the last rappel we go left in search of the Bco del Agua riverbed, we go up it for about 300m until we get over the cliff on our left and we see some terraces where we can go up to the access "path".
