Also known as de la Torre (not to be confused with Torre de Marrubio) which is the neighbor on the left and Bujamé on the right. Vertical ravine and with entity in its middle section, in which we find the jump of almost 90m fractional. It could be done without combination of vehicles going up by the PR-TF58 although the walk would be quite long.

Location of Ajoque, Marrubio, Torre and Baranda bcos.

On the road to Buenavista del Norte, with the return car we will continue towards the lighthouse / Punta de Teno on the TF445. At the p.k. 2,5 there is a deposit to the left of the road and a place to park, it is the control point of the access to the lighthouse. From here there is a PR-TF58 to the Risco. Here we will leave the return vehicle or the access car if we make the ascent on foot.

With the access vehicle we return to Buenavista, we leave by the road to El Palmar TF436, just past El Palmar we take the detour to the right to Teno Alto. We will go to Teno where we will turn right on the track La Mulata, we will continue along it until a fork that on the left is followed by the road La Mulata and on the right the road to the Tower, we get into this a few meters to park on the left.

The option of going up the PR-TF58 to the Risco is not explained, it is only left as a possibility.

From the second vehicle we follow the track about 300m until a turn to the right, just in front we have the bed of our ravine. We can go down here or a few meters ahead leaving the left side of the track in search of the most comfortable way to descend.

See topo. A first part of medium rappels until reaching the great vertical, from here the canyon loses interest.

After reaching the pool of the last rappel we will follow the riverbed through a thick reed bed, a little further down we will find a small path on the left that will cross the riverbed until we reach the junction with the PR, we will take it and continue downhill to the vehicle.
