Résumé: (traduction alternative) Generally dry ravine except after heavy rains. Without much to review of it, long access, return by the access to Bco de la Virgen or combining it with this other one. It is a descent with a lot of vegetation.		
Hydrologie: (traduction alternative) Possible in less enclosed areas		
Accès: (traduction alternative) On the A22 between Huesca and Barbastro we leave towards Abiego/Bierge A1229. In Abiego we continue towards Bierge A1227 and in Bierge towards Rodellar by the HU341. We park at the entrance of Rodellar. Be careful where we leave the car because they put fines and with the friends of the stranger that gives them to burst the crystals.		
Approche: (traduction alternative) Access to Bco de la Virgen, As Tablas and San Martín From Rodellar take the road to Cheto, after reaching the two houses of the village of Cheto, the road enters a wooded valley and reaches its other side (access to Bco de la Virgen), here comes a path to our right (to the east) that goes up the divide with the ravine of Cheto on our right. We do not go straight ahead to the Balced mountain range until the divide reaches the head of Cheto. At this point we will find a forgotten path that arrives on the right and our path turns left to the north to get right into the Bco de San Martin. Once crossed the bed, in strong ascent, our path overcomes the hillside to arrive at the Plano del Pozo. From here we will only have to look to our left for the path that descends to the riverbed.		
Tour: (traduction alternative) It is not a great descent, it can be an option for those days when everything else is impracticable and continue it with the Bco de la Virgen...		
Retour: (traduction alternative) Through the access to Bco de la Virgen or follow it and return through the Mascún.

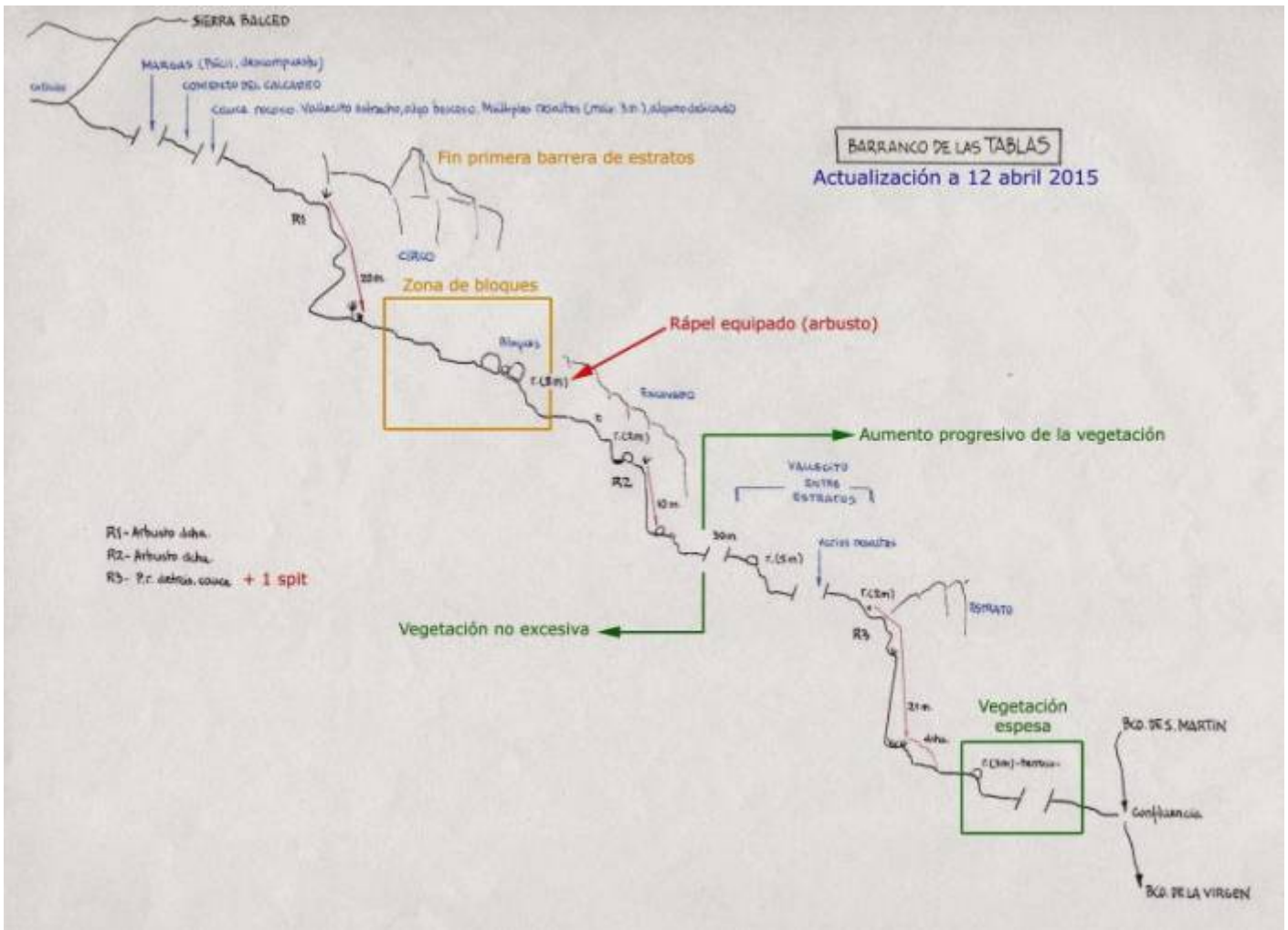
